- 3. Applicants must be under age 40 as of February 1st, 2020; and be recommended in writing by the head of the Government or Public Institution where he or she is employed;
- 4. Applicants must have completed Bachelor's Degree or equivalent in related fields;
- 5. The offer covers all costs of study including: air fare of one round-trip, tuition fees, fees for extra-curricular activities, monthly living allowance, accommodation, settlement allowance, scholarship completion grants and insurance. Any other extra expenses that are associated, or which may arise in due course will be covered personally by the candidate.
